

Adding YouTube Video link to your web site.

1. Find the YouTube video you want.
2. Copy the Embed text into your clipboard:

3. Add a Text/HTML module to your site.
4. Choose Edit Text from the context menu.
5. Choose the "Source" button to change modes.
